ALL that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being at Kinsac, in the County of Halifax, and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point marked by a cedar post on the western side of the Canadian National Railway's lands distant 89 feet more or less in a westerly direction from the old Kinsac station and 3 feet north of the spruce hedge being the southeastern corner of the lands now or formerly owned by Nicholson;

THENCE in a westerly direction 133 feet more or less or until it comes to a post near a birch and spruce tree;

THENCE in a southerly direction along an old stone pile 97 feet more or less to the lands now or formerly owned by R.P. Mack and marked by an oak stump;

THENCE in an easterly direction 190 feet more or less or until it reaches the boundary of the Canadian National Railway property;

THENCE in a northerly direction along the line of the said Canadian National Railway properties 100 feet more or less or until it comes to the place of beginning being known as the Doctor Morton lot.

The Parcel complies with the subdivision provisions of Part IX of the Municipal Government Act.
