Subject: Amendments to the Timberlea/Lakeside/Beechville Land Use By-law to rezone vacant R-4 (Multi-Unit Dwelling) Zone properties to the R-1	
Motion for Halifax and West Community Council to Consider: THAT Halifax and West Community Council direct the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) to provide a staff recommendation report regarding amendments to the Timberlea/Lakeside/Beechville Land Use Bylaw to rezone vacant R-4 (Multi-Unit Dwelling) Zone properties to the R-1 (Single Unit Dwelling) Zone to enable the lands for residential development.	
Reason: The R-4 (Multi-Unit Dwelling) Zone only permits existing multiple-unit dwellings and prohibits the development of any new residential uses. As a result, vacant R-4 zoned lots cannot be developed. To support the goals of the Statement of Provincial Interest Regarding Housing, I am requesting a staff report to explore amendments to the Timberlea/Lakeside/Beechville Land Use By-law that would allow residential development on these lands.	
Outcome Sought: Vacant R-4 zoned lands to be rezoned to allow for residential development.
