SUBJECT: Board of Police Commissioners Revised 2025 Meeting Schedule

#### **ORIGIN**

Staff-initiated report.

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board of Police Commissioners for the Halifax Regional Municipality approve the proposed revised meeting schedule for 2025 as outlined in Attachment 1 of this report.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Board of Police Commissioners for the Halifax Regional Municipality (BoPC) current meeting schedule includes six regular meetings in 2025 (January 8, 2025, February 3, 2025, April 2, 2025, June 4, 2025, September 3, 2025 and December 3, 2025). Due to the BoPC's agenda requirements additional meetings were scheduled for March 3, 2025 and May 7, 2025. The May 7, 2025 meeting was cancelled due to a lack of quorum and a replacement meeting was held on May 21, 2025.

BoPC Meetings are typically held on the first Wednesday of the month starting at 1:00 p.m. in-person at the HEMDCC Meeting Space, Main Floor Alderney Landing, 60 Alderney Drive, Dartmouth. The BoPC's meetings are currently scheduled for five hours, with a scheduled end time of 6:00 p.m.

# **DISCUSSION**

The BoPC's proposed revised 2025 meeting schedule [Attachment 1] provides for two additional regular meetings on October 1, 2025 and November 12, 2025 in order for the BoPC to address current and projected staff reports and agenda items. These meetings will continue to be held on the first Wednesday

of the month and will be held in-person at the Harbour East Marine Drive meeting space beginning at 1:00 p.m. Meetings are scheduled for five hours in duration, with a scheduled end time of 6:00 p.m.

The addition of two additional regular meetings to the BoPC's 2025 meeting schedule satisfies the *Police Act* requirement that the BoPC meet every three months [*Police Act*, 2004, S.N.S. 2004, c. 31, section 49]. If additional meetings are required, they can be added through motion or called by the chair of the BoPC to address a specific item or issue.

The recommended revised meeting schedule also includes the BoPC's 2026/2027 budget review meetings beginning with a meeting on September 24, 2025 where Halifax Regional Police (HRP) will present their 2026/2027 operating budget high level asks, including service enhancements, and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Halifax Regional Detachment (RCMP HRD) will present their 2026/2027 resource requests. On Monday October 6, 2025 the BoPC will hold a virtual meeting beginning at 4:00 p.m. to receive public consultation on the HRP 2026/2027 operating budget high level asks and the RCMP HRD 2026/2027 resource requests. The October 29, 2025 meeting will include the submission of detailed reports on HRP's detailed draft 2026/2027 operating budget and RCMP HRD's 2026/2027 resource requests. The October 29, 2025 meeting will also include BoPC discussion, debate and vote on the recommendations to be made to Regional Council regarding HRP's draft 2026/2027 operating budget and RCMP HRD's 2026/2027 resource requests. If the BoPC request changes to be made to HRP's draft 2026/2027 operating budget and RCMP HRD's 2026/2027 resource requests, a contingency meeting is scheduled for November 5, 2025 for the Board to review the changes and vote on the recommendations to Regional Council. One of the BoPC's 2026/2027 budget review meetings is scheduled for a day other than the Board's normal Wednesday meeting date due to scheduling conflicts.
