




- Volunteer-led national charity based in Halifax founded in 1982

- Platform for **commemoration**, **education**, **and cultural events e**ngaging youth, veterans, and communities in shared remembrance
- Honouring military and naval history and Connects Halifax's WWII naval history to today's shipbuilding and port communities
