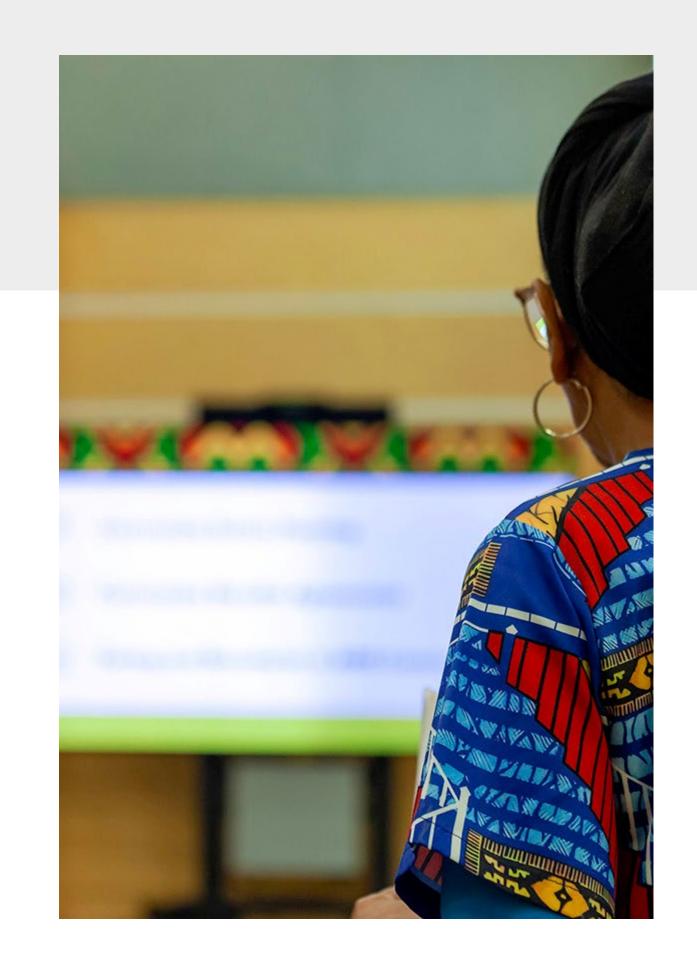
REP began as a Community led, 5 -year initiative that takes a collaborative approach

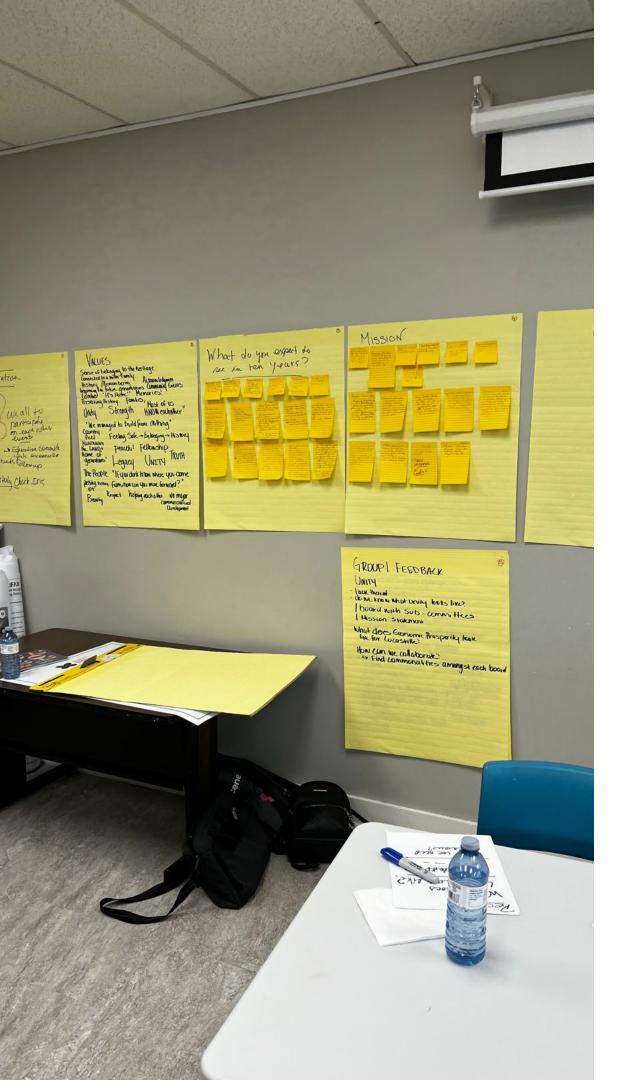
