Be safe with your batteries and always:



Buy smart

- Stick with trusted brands and avoid cheap, offbrand devices

 they may lack proper safety certification and pose fire risks.
- Look for CSA, cUL, or cETL marks to confirm Canadian safety standards. No mark? No thanks.



Charge safe

- Always use the charging cords that came with the product and follow all manufacturer's instructions.
- Buy new chargers from the manufacturer or one they have approved.
- Always charge devices on a hard surface — never on a couch, bed, or under a pillow.
- Unplug when fully charged.
- Never leave devices unattended while charging.



Recycle right

- Never throw them in garbage bins, recycling bins, or green bins because they could start a fire.
- Bring your device or battery to a safe battery recycling location. Visit <u>halifax.ca/recycle</u> to find a spot near you.
