



Canadian Naval Memorial Trust (CNMT)

- Volunteer-led national charity based in Halifax founded in 1982
- Stewards HMCS Sackville, last surviving WWII corvette. Commemorates 100,000+ Canadians who served in the Royal Canadian Navy and a living memorial to the 4,500 lost at sea
- HMCS SACKVILLE was designated as Canada's National Naval Memorial in 1984









Why Sackville Matters Locally

- Iconic Halifax waterfront site drawing up to 45,000 visitors annually
- Platform for **commemoration**, **education**, **and cultural events e**ngaging youth, veterans, and communities in shared remembrance
- Honouring military and naval history and Connects Halifax's WWII naval history to today's shipbuilding and port communities
