

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

LISA MACINTYRE-SMITH ET AL have appealed to the Nova Scotia Regulatory and Appeals Board from a decision of the Chief Administrative Officer for the Halifax Regional Municipality to approve a modification to the restrictive covenant allowing a four unit building at 6 Ramsbrook Court, Halifax, Nova Scotia (PID 41276940). - You may request formal standing as an Intervenor, subject to Board approval. This will allow you to present evidence or cross-examine witnesses. Your request must be received by the Board by Wednesday, October 22, 2025, and a copy of your written evidence by Wednesday, November 26, 2025, for Intervenors supporting the Appellants, and by Thursday, December 11, 2025, for Intervenors supporting the Municipality.
- You may request the hearing be audio or videocast. Your request must be received by the Board by Monday, December 18, 2025. The Board will make its best effort to accommodate any such request.
