ALL that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the Hardwood Acres Subdivision at Upper Sackville, in the County of Halifax, Province of Nova Scotia, shown as Lot 13 on a plan prepared by Frank Longstaff, Nova Scotia Land Surveyor, dated July 30, 1968 and revised on the following dates: October 29, 1968, May 5, 1969 and June 11, 1969; which said lot was approved by the Halifax County Planning Board on October 14, 1969. Said Lot containing 19,000 square feet more or less and more particularly described as follows:

THENCE to run North 02 degrees 24 minutes 27 seconds East along the eastern boundary a portion of lands formerly owned by Lewis Leroy Maxwell for a distance of 33.48 feet unto an iron bar set in the ground at the southern boundary of lands formerly owned by Victor Maxwell, Robert Maxwell and Reginald Maxwell;

THENCE to run North 51 degrees 53 minutes 38 seconds East along said southern boundary a distance of 83 feet unto an iron bar set in the ground at the southwestern corner of Lot 12 aforesaid;

THENCE to run South 57 degrees 48 minutes 06 seconds East along the southern boundary of aid Lot 12 a distance of 189.15 feet or unto the place of beginning.


