

SCHEDULE "A"

ALL that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situated lying and being on the North side of Glendale Avenue, at Dutch Village, in the County of Halifax, being Lot No. 43 according to the plan of Block "D", Sunnybrae Subdivision, prepared and signed by Charles P. Roper, Provincial Land Surveyor, dated June 16, 1946, on file in the Registry of Deeds for the County of Halifax as plan No. 531, and which said lot is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Northern boundary line of Glendale Avenue at the South-West Corner of Lot No. 42;

THENCE Westwardly along the Northern boundary line of Glendale Avenue Fifty (50) feet, more or less, to the South-East corner of Lot No. 44;

THENCE Northwardly along the Eastern boundary of said Lot No. 44 One Hundred and Twelve and Five tenths (112.5) feet, more or less, to the Southern boundary line of lands formerly owned by one A. I. Cook;

THENCE Eastwardly along the southern boundary line of the last named lands Fifty and One Tenth (50.1) feet, more or less to the North-West corner of Lot No. 42;

THENCE Southwardly along the Western boundary of said Lot No. 42 One Hundred and Eleven and Five tenths (111.5) feet, more or less, to the place of beginning.
