LOT ONE

All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the City of Halifax, in the County of Halifax and Province of Nova Scotia and being Lot 4 on a plan of lands on Bayers Road dated February 29th, 1952 and revised November 1, 1955, and signed by G. M. Hilchie, C.E., P.L.S., and on file in the Registry of Deeds at Halifax, the said lot being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the present northeastern street line of Bayers Moad where it is intersected by the southeastern boundary of lands now owned by Francis B. Walker as shown on said plan;

-THENCE southereasterly along said street line seventeen point three (17.3) feet to its intersection with the northwestern boundary of Lot #1;

THENCE northeasterly along the said northwestern boundary and the northeastern prolongation thereof one hundred and eleven point three (111.3) feet to its intersection with the southwestern boundary of lands of Edgewood Subdivision;

THEMCE northwesterly along said southwestern boundary seventy-six feet to its intersection with the northeastern prolongation of the northwestern boundary of lands owned by Francis B. Walker, aforesaid:

THENCE southwesterly along said southeastern boundary ninety-seven point six (97.6) feet to the point of beginning.

LOT TWO

ALSO ALL that certain lot, piece or parcel of land Situate, lying and being in the City of Halifax and County of Halifax, in the Province of Nova Scotia and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pipe set on the northeastern boundary line of Bayers Road, the said iron pipe being distant thirty-nine feet, measured in a southeastwardly direction from the most southwardly angle of the dwelling house owned and occupied by the said Grantors and also distant two hundred and ten feet measured northwestwardly in a direct line from a stake set at and marking the most westwardly angle of that lot formerly conveyed by the said Bert Walker to said Driscilla Walker:

THENCE from the said iron pipe and point of beginning to run northeastwardly and parallel with the northwestern boundary line of the said lot formerly conveyed to said Driscilla Walker one hundred feet unto a squared stake;

THENCE to run southeastwardly and parallel with the said northeastern boundary line of Bayers Road fifty feet unto a squared stake;
