

SCHEDULE "A"

ALL that parcel of land situated in Terence Bay, in the County of Halifax, Nova Scotia, and being part of land formerly in possession of John George Slauenwhite and bounded as follows, that is to say:

BEGINNING at a large rock, just above high water mark on Beach known as Terence Bay Beach ;

THENCE running north by west about three and a half ($3\frac{1}{2}$) chains to a stake then and there placed against the fence running parallel with the Main road ;

THENCE following said Main Road twenty-four (24) yards more or less to a stake there driven ;

THENCE southeast by south half quarter south about three (3) chains more or less, to a large boulder rock by a fish flake formerly owned by John George Slauenwhite ;

THENCE southwest by west to the place of beginning, including in all about three-quarters ($\frac{3}{4}$) of an acre, more or less, being the lot of land conveyed to George Henry Slauenwhite by John George Slauenwhite and Mary, his wife, by Deed dated October 22nd, 1885, and recorded in the Registry of Deed at Halifax in Book 268, pages 129 and 130.

TOGETHER WITH all and singular the buildings, Easements, Tenements, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the same belonging, or in anywise appertaining, with the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof, and all the estate, right, tilte, interest, claim, property and demand, both at law and in equity of the said Grantor of, in, to or out of the same, or any part thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Land and Premises with the appurtenances, and every part thereof, unto the said Grantee, heer Heirs and Assigns to her and their sole use, benefit and behoof forever.
