SUBJECT: Board of Police Commissioners 2026 Meeting Schedule

ORIGIN

Staff-initiated report.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

An annual schedule for the Board of Police Commissioners is adopted each fall the upcoming calendar year.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Police Commissioners for the Halifax Regional Municipality approve the proposed meeting schedule for 2026 as outlined in Attachment 1 of this report.

BACKGROUND

The Board of Police Commissioners for the Halifax Regional Municipality (BoPC) currently meets the first Wednesday of each month starting at 1:00 p.m. in-person at the HEMDCC Meeting Space, Main Floor Alderney Landing, 60 Alderney Drive, Dartmouth. The BoPC's monthly meetings are currently scheduled for five hours, with a scheduled end time of 6:00 p.m.

DISCUSSION

The recommended meeting schedule [Attachment 1] provides for ten regular meetings in 2026 held at the Harbour East Marine Drive meeting space beginning at 1:00 p.m. The meetings are scheduled for five hours

in duration, with a scheduled end time of 6:00 p.m. The BoPC typically meets on the first Wednesday of the month, however the Board's February and March 2026 meetings are scheduled to be held on Mondays to accommodate the schedule of the BoPC's 3 Councillor appointees who are scheduled to attend Budget Committee meetings on Wednesdays during these months. The BoPC's 2026 regular meeting dates satisfies the *Police Act* requirement that the BoPC meet every three months [*Police Act*, 2004, S.N.S. 2004, c. 31, section 49].

The recommended meeting schedule [Attachment 1] includes a meeting on Monday February 23, 2026 in case the Budget Committee after its February 4-6, 2026 review of the Halifax Regional Police (HRP) and the Royal Canadian Mount Police Halifax Regional Detachment (RCMP HRD) budget presentations asks the Board to further review HRP's 2026/2027 operating budget and RCMP HRD's 2026/2027 staff complement request.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

No financial implications at this time.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

No community engagement was required.

ALTERNATIVES

The Board of Police Commissioners for the Halifax Regional Municipality could choose not to approve the recommendation.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

Police Act. 2004, S.N.S. 2004, c. 31, section 49, states:

The board must hold a board meeting at least every three months.
