Subject: Staff report on metrics to use to assess effectiveness of police services		
Motion for Board of Police Commissioners for the Halifax Regional Municipality to Consider: That the Board of Police Commissioners for the Halifax Regional Municipality direct the policing policy strategist to provide a staff report on recommended metrics to use to assess the effectiveness of police services, with reference to best practices in Canada and globally. Reason: Tracking metrics on effectiveness of police services are one way the Board of Police Commissioners can assess how well police services are being delivered and how adherent they are to community priorities. Outcome Sought: The Board of Police Commissioners will have a recommended set of metrics of effectiveness of police services that will be maintained on a regular basis with input from HRP and HRD and others, which will be used to track the effectiveness of police services and inform decision making on resource allocation and prioritisation over time.
