Report of Committee on S. & B.

A verbal report from the Committee on School Sites and Buildings, just adjourned was submitted as follows: -

" The Contractors whose tenders for erection of schools were
 " been accepted on Sept. 4. have been interviewed by
 " the Committee and, in view of itemised eliminations
 " from specifications and the substitution of less
 " expensive materials in the construction of the build-
 " ings have consented to reduce their original estimates
 " to the following: -

Bloomfield	193,070 -
Richmond	236,929.50
St. Joseph's	245,136 -
St. Patrick's Boys'	297,294 -

" That a form of agreement between the Board and the
 " Contractor has been prepared, submitted to the City
 " Solicitor and approved by him, the Committee therefore
 " recommends its adoption by the Board.

" The Principal of Joseph Howe School reports that
