Gentlemen:-

The Board of Control beg to report for the information of the City Council that A. S. Barnstead, Chief Mortuary Officer for the City of Halifax, has made arrangements with the Fairview Cemetery Co., Ltd., and D. Lynagh, representing the Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation for Mount Olivet Cemetery, that all unidentified bodies for which the City agrees to become responsible may be buried in public lots in these cemeteries; the land will be given free of charge. What land is required for family lots or single graves, a charge not exceeding 20¢ per sq. ft. will be made.
