# Volunteer Awards 2023 GROUP Award Nomination Form

Each year the Halifax Regional Municipality, the Mayor and Regional Council recognize the extraordinary contributions of individuals and groups who volunteer their time and skills to provide services and programs in our communities.

#### **Nomination Criteria**

- The Group Volunteer Award is open for any volunteer group (a club, society, or association that is organized and operated without the purpose of making profit) that has made a significant impact on building stronger communities through services, programs, projects and/or events and delivers these in the region.
- This is a scored process, which means all areas of the nomination form must be completed and well explained. Nominations that are incomplete, inaccurate, late or do not comply with the below criteria may be not be accepted.
- Groups who meet the following criteria are eligible for a Volunteer Award:
  - Demonstrates initiative, leadership and creativity in service to others;
  - · Has a plan for sustainability;
  - Shows successful partnerships or collaborations; and
  - Improves the overall quality of life of citizens and the community.
- It is important to illustrate the impact the group has had and capture as much of the group's history as possible.
- The group's volunteer efforts listed on this form must be voluntary and not part of their day to day employment functions.
- Volunteer groups that are nominated are eligible for an award in only one of the three categories. On the following form, please select the category that fits the group you are nominating.
  - Category 1: Community group with annual finances and grants under \$50,000
  - Category 2: Community group with annual finances and grants exceeding \$50,000
  - Category 3: Community youth group (youth volunteers up to 25 years old)
- The volunteer group cannot have received this award in the last 4 years. To find out if they have received the award, please call 902-456-9683.

#### **Award Selection Process**

- All nominations are scored. One award is allotted for each of the three group categories.
- All nominees and award recipients are presented to Executive Standing Committee of Council for final approval.
- All nominees will receive a letter, either to thank them for their community contribution, or inviting them to the Volunteer Awards Ceremony in April to receive a certificate from the Mayor and Council.
- The selected group from each category will be notified if they have been selected to receive an award mid-March. Two representatives from the selected groups may attend to accept the award.
