- Construction activity is much higher this quarter than at the same time last year when there was only 101,522 SF under construction.
- 60,800 SF of new construction commenced, bringing total construction activity to 260,800 SF
- The availability rate decreased from 6.8% last quarter to 6.6%.
- The unemployment rate in Halifax improved from 6.8% last quarter to 5.7% this quarter according to Statistics Canada.
