

## Financial Incentives Program

### Application form for grants within the Schmitville and Old South Suburb Heritage Conservation Districts

#### Program aim

The aim of this incentives program is to provide financial assistance to property owners, within the boundaries of the Schmitville Heritage Conservation District (HCD) and Old South Suburb HCD, to support the conservation of contributing heritage resources and the revitalization of all existing buildings in the districts. The program provides:

-Conservation Grants will cover 50 per cent of the costs associated with exterior conservation work, up to \$50,000

-Functional Improvement Grants will cover 15 per cent of the costs associated with installation or repair essential building systems, up to \$400,000.

*Note: Late or incomplete applications will not be reviewed. Additionally, work that has been undertaken prior to the application being made will be deemed ineligible.*

#### Application requirements:

Please include the following documents with your application and check each of the following boxes:

A completed and signed application form;

Recent photographs of all sides of the building, illustrating the areas of work for which the grant is applied;

Two contractors quotes for each of the proposed work types; and

Buildings governed by a condominium by-law must also provide a copy of the board of director's minutes approving the submission of the application.

## **Priority criteria:**

Preference is given to the following criteria:

1. Properties identified as contributing heritage resources.
2. First-time applicants.
3. Preservation and restoration of historic structural and weather-proofing elements.
4. Restoration of publicly visible features.
5. Applications supported by a Building Conservation Plan prepared by an architect, building inspector, engineer, or other qualified restoration professional.
6. Rehabilitation and restoration projects that improve the integrity of a building.
7. Applications submitted by neighbouring property owners of attached buildings on abutting properties.
8. Properties in poor condition and at risk of deterioration or loss.

*Note: Properties currently under investigation or prosecution for Land-use, Building or Fire Code, or Heritage Property Act violations, or subject to an Order to Comply, or has liens/ taxes outstanding are not eligible.*

## **Heritage alteration approval**

Within the Schmitzville HCD and Old South Suburb HCD approval is required for any exterior alteration. This approval is a necessary pre-requisite for a grant application to ensure that the municipality's Standards and Guidelines for Heritage Properties have been met prior to the granting of funds. Additionally, building permits may be required. Grant applications cannot be approved without building permit approval, where required.

## **Application deadline**

- The application form must be completed and returned to the Heritage Property Program Office by **March 1, 2025**.
- Applications will not be considered complete unless all required supporting documentation has been submitted. Incomplete application forms will be returned and will be ineligible for grants.

## **Collection and use statement:**

In accordance with Section 485 of the Municipal Government Act (MGA), any personal information collected on this application form will only be used by municipal staff and, if necessary, individuals and/or organizations under service contract with the Halifax Regional Municipality for purposes relating to administration of the Financial Incentives Program.
