9.2 2017 Provincial Heritage Conference Committee Update

Seamus McGreal, Heritage Planner, Planning and Development, advised that Halifax will be hosting the Provincial Heritage Conference for the first time this year, discussing the history of the conference, which has been held annually for the past 15 years. A planning committee will be struck to plan and organize the conference, consisting of three members of the Heritage Advisory Committee (HAC), three legacy members, and staff. Seamus noted that Jason Cooke and Melanie Baker from the HAC have indicated an interest and done some initial work with Seamus, and that one more HAC member should be nominated.

Seamus indicated that the conference will be held November 1 - 3, 2017 at the Westin Hotel and the slogan will be "Working Together". A keynote speaker is Marc Denhez, a renowned expert in the housing renovation industry. Themes will include the Halifax Explosion and Africville /Mikmaq/Millbrook/Tufts Cove communities. The heritage building renovation industry will take part in the conference. Funding for the conference comes from the Province, private sector sponsorship, and HRM has contributed \$10,000. Staff are looking to Destination Halifax for website and administration assistance with the conference. The planning committee will next meet in mid-July to determine presenters and speakers.

Iona Stoddard and David Williamson expressed interest, although David indicated that he may be unavailable in the fall.

Seamus advised that HAC members could be involved with the conference in other ways.
