**RESPECTING THE CLOSURE OF THE MILO STREET RESERVE**

1. The portion of the Milo Street reserve located on the east side of Trenholm Street, more particularly described in Schedule "A", attached hereto, is hereby closed.

## **SCHEDULE “A”**

Milo Street Reserve  
(Northeast of Trenholm Street)

**All** that certain parcel of land lying, being and situate on the northeastern side of Trenholm Street. South Woodside, in the County of Halifax, Province of Nova Scotia, and being a portion of the Milo Street road reserve more particularly shown on a plan of subdivision (being Plan 637 in the Registry of Deeds, at Halifax) of lands of Millard Trenholm, and said portion of Milo Street road reserve being more particularly described as follows:

**Beginning** at the intersection of the northeastern side-line of Trenholm Street with the southeastern boundary of Lot 13, said point being the southern corner of said Lot 13;

**Thence** northeasterly along the southeastern boundary of Lot 13, 101.66 feet, to the eastern corner of said lot, said corner being a point on the southwestern boundary of lands now or formerly owned by Irving Oil Company Limited;

**Thence** southeasterly along the southwestern boundary of lands now or formerly owned by Irving Oil Company Limited, 50 feet more or less to the northern corner of Lot 14;

**Thence** southwesterly along the northwestern boundary of Lot 14, 101.66 feet, to the western corner of Lot 14, said corner being a point on the northeastern side-line of Trenholm Street;

**Thence** northwesterly crossing Milo Street, 50 feet more or less, to the Point of Beginning.

**Being** or intended to be a portion of those lands conveyed to Frank Mosher in a deed on file in the Registry of Deeds at Halifax in Book 3467 Page 41.
