Schedule "A"
"Isleview Lane"

ALL THAT parcel of land situate in Bedford, in the County of Halifax and Province of Nova Scotia, lying between the Bedford Highway and Shore Drive, outlined and shaded in red on a Plan of Survey of Portion of Bedford Highway and Shore Drive dated December 14, 1982 prepared by Wallace MacDonald & Lively and signed by A. E. Wallace, N.S.L.S. more particularly bounded and described as follows:

COMMENCING at Nova Scotia Coordinate Monument 22170;

THENCE North 59 degrees 34 minutes 31 seconds East a distance of 462.43 feet to a Survey Marker on the Northern Boundary of lands now or formerly of the Canadian Government Railway;

THENCE North 57 degrees 18 minutes 56 seconds East a distance of 56.78 feet along the Northern Boundary of lands now or formerly of the Canadian Government Railway to a Survey Marker being the point and place of beginning;

THENCE North 77 degrees 49 minutes 46 seconds East a distance of 101.60 feet to a Survey Marker on the Northern Boundary of Shore Drive;

THENCE North 50 degrees 42 minutes 43 seconds East a distance of 144.79 feet to a Survey Marker on the Northern Boundary of Shore Drive;

THENCE South 77 degrees 49 minutes 46 seconds West a distance of 112.81 feet to a Survey Marker on the Northern Boundary of the property now or formerly of the Canadian Government Railway and the Southern Boundary of the Bedford Highway;

THENCE Westerly to the point and place of beginning.
