Your Worship,

This year's parade and remembrance of military personnel who served and gave their lives onboard HMCS KOOTENAY will occur on Wednesday, 23 October 2019. The ceremony will consist of a military parade through Point Pleasant Park and a brief religious service at the HMCS BONAVENTURE Memorial. The event will also include the participation of an HMC Ship just seaward of the memorial and a fly-past by military aviation.

A CP-140 Aurora and CH-148 Cyclone will pass over the HMCS BONAVENTURE Memorial. It is requested that the Halifax Regional Municipality grant permission for the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) to fly RCAF assets in formation over Point Pleasant Park as per the enclosed diagram (routed from sea and turning inland to fly directly over the memorial), at an altitude of 500 feet above the highest obstacles. This event will occur at 10:28 AM on 23 October 2019.

Subject to the city's authorization, CAF will execute in a timely manner the release of Notice to Airmen messages and public advisories of the over-flight activity.

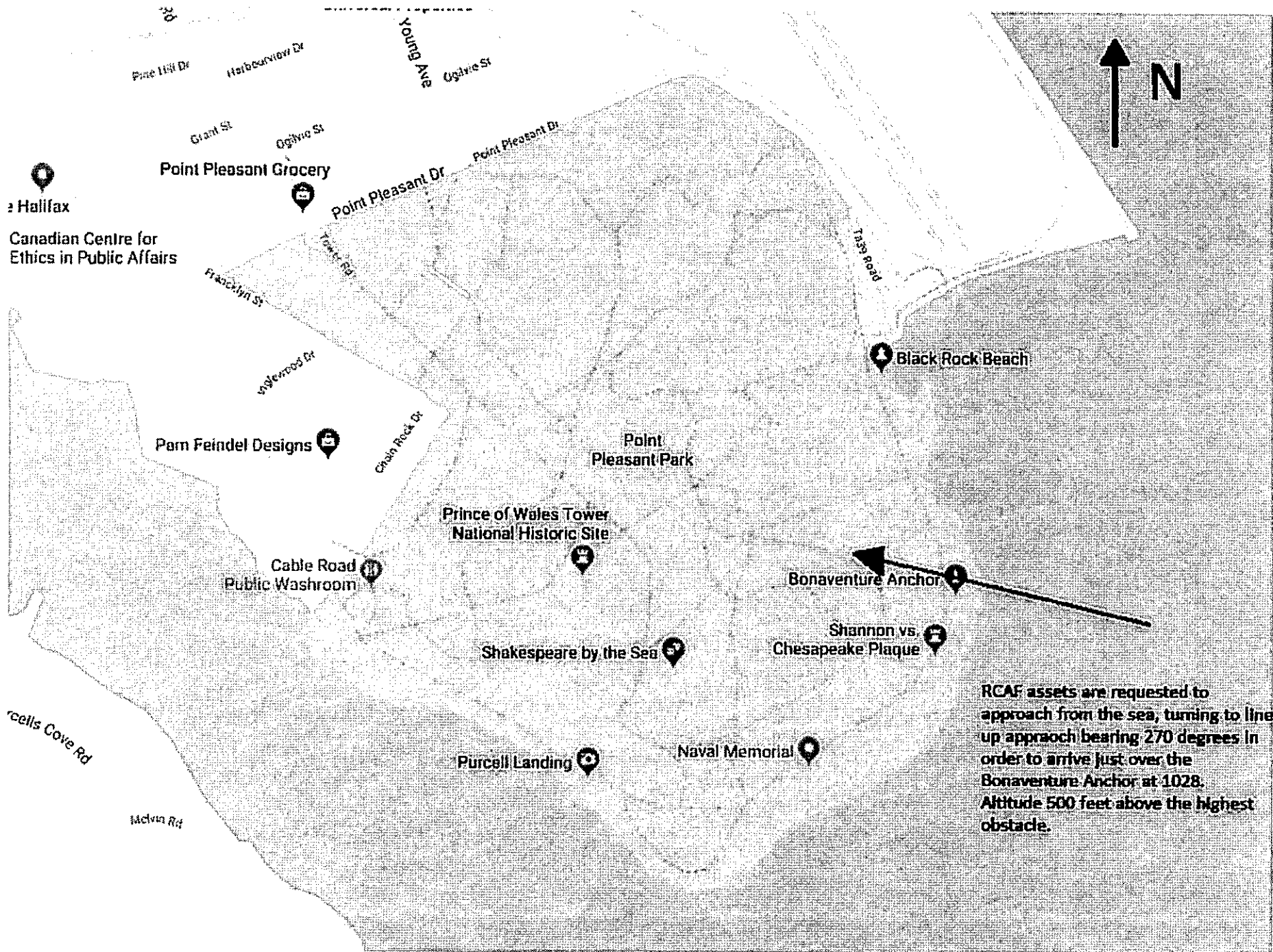
