Powers of the Committee

4. The Committee shall, within the time limits prescribed by Council or the Act, advise the Region respecting:

(d) the preparation, amendment, revision or repeal of a conservation plan and conservation by-law;

(e) the administration of heritage conservation districts;

RECOMMENDATION

The Heritage Advisory Committee recommends that Halifax Regional Council initiate a process to research and evaluate potential heritage properties, identified in Attachment A and B of the August 4, 2022 report, collaborating as appropriate with the specific university, for consideration for registration as municipal heritage properties in accordance with the Heritage Property Act and By-law H-200, the Heritage Property By-law.
