Neurofibromatosis Awareness Day May 17th, 2023

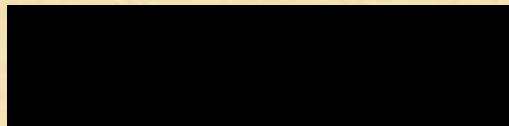
WHEREAS, neurofibromatosis affects 1:3,000 births worldwide and an estimated 12,000 Canadians live with this condition, and
