<b>Subject: Heritage de-registration of PID41518333 – surplus lands York Redoubt</b>		
<b>Motion for Council to Consider:</b>  That Halifax Regional Council direct the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) to provide a staff report initiating a heritage de-registration of PID41518333 (Lot 1SM1-1), a subdivided portion of a registered heritage property known as York Redoubt, located at 12 York Redoubt Crescent, Ferguson's Cove, Nova Scotia.		
<b>Reason:</b>  York Redoubt is a National Historical Site with several acres of land. The owners of Star of the Sea, a bed and breakfast in Ferguson's cove are entering into a new community project. By de-registering this vacant parcel which do not contain any character-defining elements will allow the owners to continue their project as well as apply for the appropriate planning permit.
