Flyby Letter – Highway of Heroes 17 August 2024

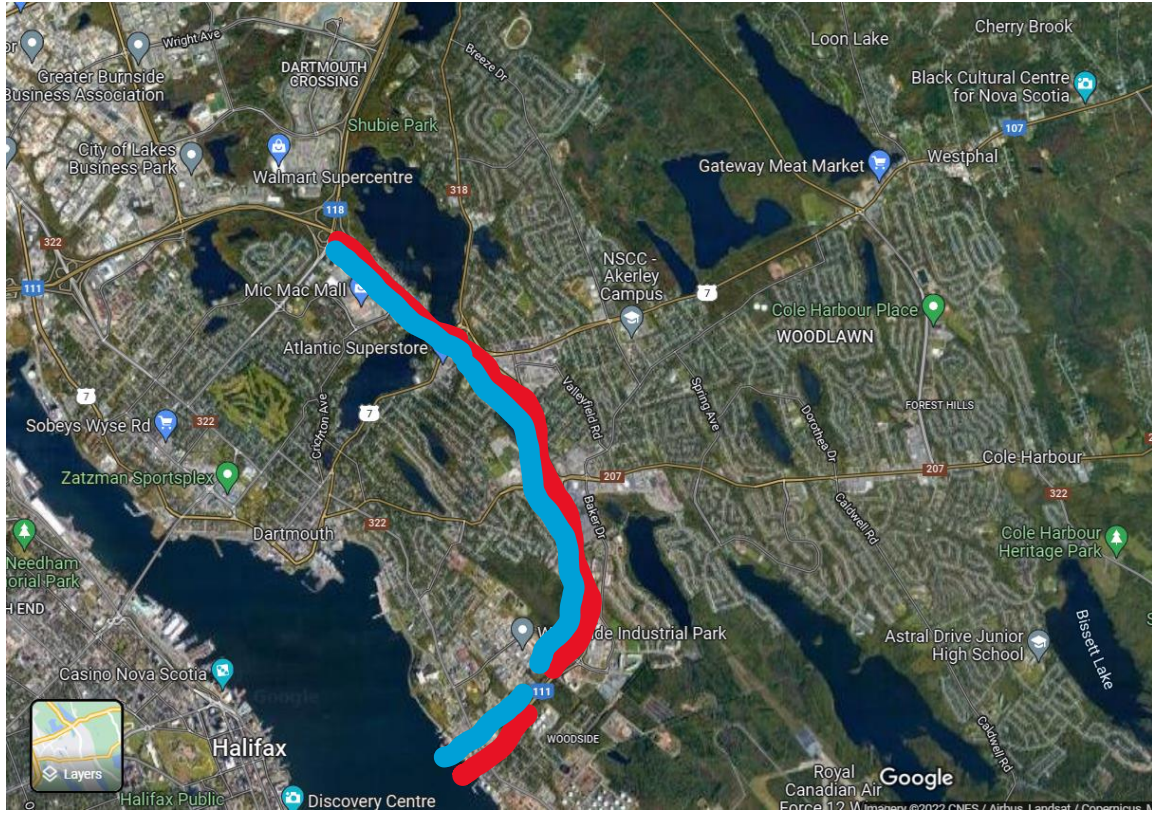
