Ken Stuebing, Executive Director/Fire Chief, Halifax Regional Fire & Emergency, Bruce Lake, Division Chief, Safety & Compliance, Halifax Regional Fire & Emergency, and Jennifer Mark, Policy & Business Initiatives Coordinator, Halifax Regional Fire & Emergency gave a presentation and responded to questions of clarification from Committee of the Whole.

Stuebing spoke to the initial incident response, timelines and objectives for policy review and accreditation, coordination with fire and emergency partners including the Department of Natural Resources and Renewables, fire and emergency communications, and community education and engagement initiatives.

Kara McCurdy, Wildfire Mitigation Program Manager, Halifax Regional Fire & Emergency spoke to current wildfire mitigation initiatives including the development of a Community Risk Assessment, equipment investments and technology improvements. McCurdy spoke to relevant parties sharing responsibilities for investigations, fines and enforcement.

Lake spoke to service standards for the provision of first aid as a component of incident response.

Cathie O'Toole, Chief Administrative Officer spoke to municipal emergency and crisis communications initiatives, investments in technology improvements, and interfacing with other orders of government.

Brad Anguish, Commissioner of Operations spoke to emergency egress standards for road and highway infrastructure, secondary access policies, cooperation and advocacy with other orders of government.
