THAT the the Community Planning and Economic Development Standing Committee Standing Committee request a staff report to explore the possibility of waiving all or any of the fees payable pursuant to provisions of By-law E-200 where an existing encroachment is being enlarged or modified to facilitate barrier free access to either residential or commercial properties. Mayor Savage addressed the motion advising that it recently came to his attention there were businesses trying to create barrier-free accessibility at their locations but were incurring fines because they were encroaching on municipal property. He indicated that he would like staff to look into this matter and see if something could be done for those properties that are trying to provide a barrier free access to their businesses but were penalized due to an encroachment.

Councillor Watts noted that this was issue in the North End as well, in particular, when a business changes and the new business is faced with an encroachment.
