HRP MISSION, VISION AND VALUES STATEMENT

- D. The HRP values articulate the fundamental beliefs of the HRP and serve as standards for our members towards maintaining professional conduct at all times with: People, respect, integrity, relationships and communication.
 - i. People: Our primary concern.
 - ii. Respect: Everyone is respected.
 - iii. Integrity: We do the right thing, in the right way, for the right reasons.
 - iv. Relationships: Community relationships are the foundation from which we work
 - v. Communication: Open, honest and constructive communication always matters.
- E. **Strategic Impact** To make ongoing and meaningful contributions to the well-being and safety of our communities.

3. DEFINITIONS

- F. **Mission Statement** refers to a set of principles that indicate the nature and ultimate purpose of an organization.
- G. Value Statement speaks to the traditions and dedication of the community, Halifax Regional Police and its entire staff. It promotes values that are consistent with legal and cultural realities and maintains the highest standards of professionalism.
