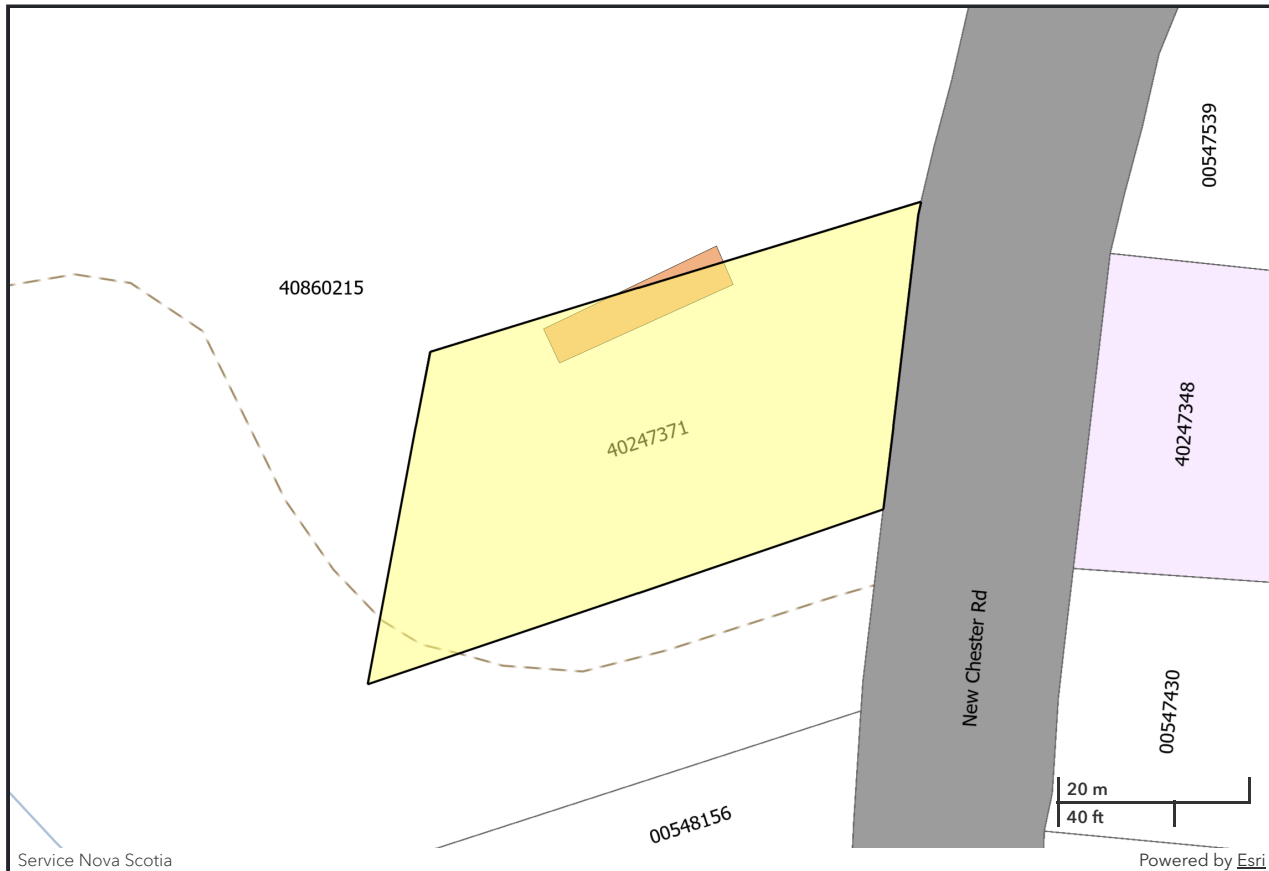
AAN 03645002

ALL THAT CERTAIN piece or parcel of land bounded and described as follows: that is to say - Beginning at a rock marked Y on the south line of lands purchased by Charles E. Pace from George Burnham. Thence south twenty five degrees east to the main road or to a rock marked X. Thence southerly by the main road thirty six paces or to a rock marked A. Thence northwest-twenty six paces or to a rock marked M. Thence North fifty eight paces or to a rock marked P on the line of said land purchased by Charles Pace from George Burnham. Thence by line of said land to the place of beginning and comprising one quarter acre there about.
