

SCHEDULE "A"

ALL those certain lots, pieces or parcels of land situate at or near Port Dufferin aforesaid (Formerly known as Salmon River) abutted and bounded as follows, that is to say, that certain lot of land situate at Beaver Harbour, called and known by the name of Lake Hill, and bounded as follows:

BEGINNING at the South East angle of the said lot;

THENCE running North along Hales Line which forms the Eastern boundary

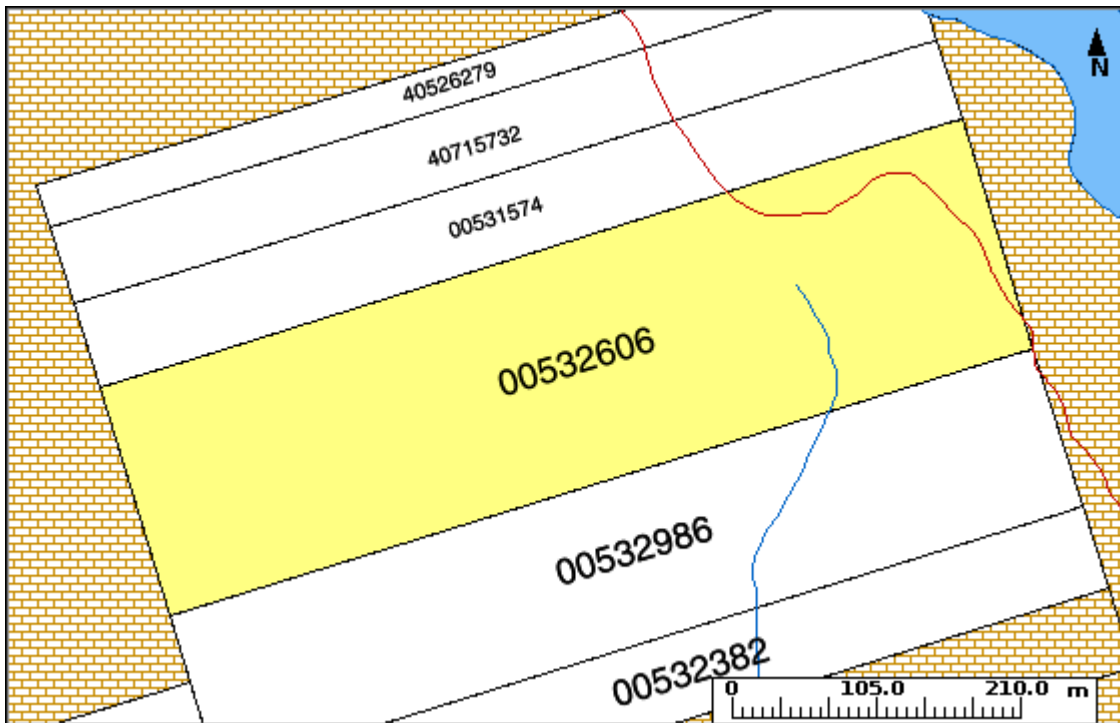
~~of the said lot till it strikes John Hartlings line, which bounds it on~~
