

SCHEDULE "A"

The following lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being at

BEGINNING at a blazed spruce tree, thence running north 23 degrees west a distance of 2.34 chains to a blazed fir tree;

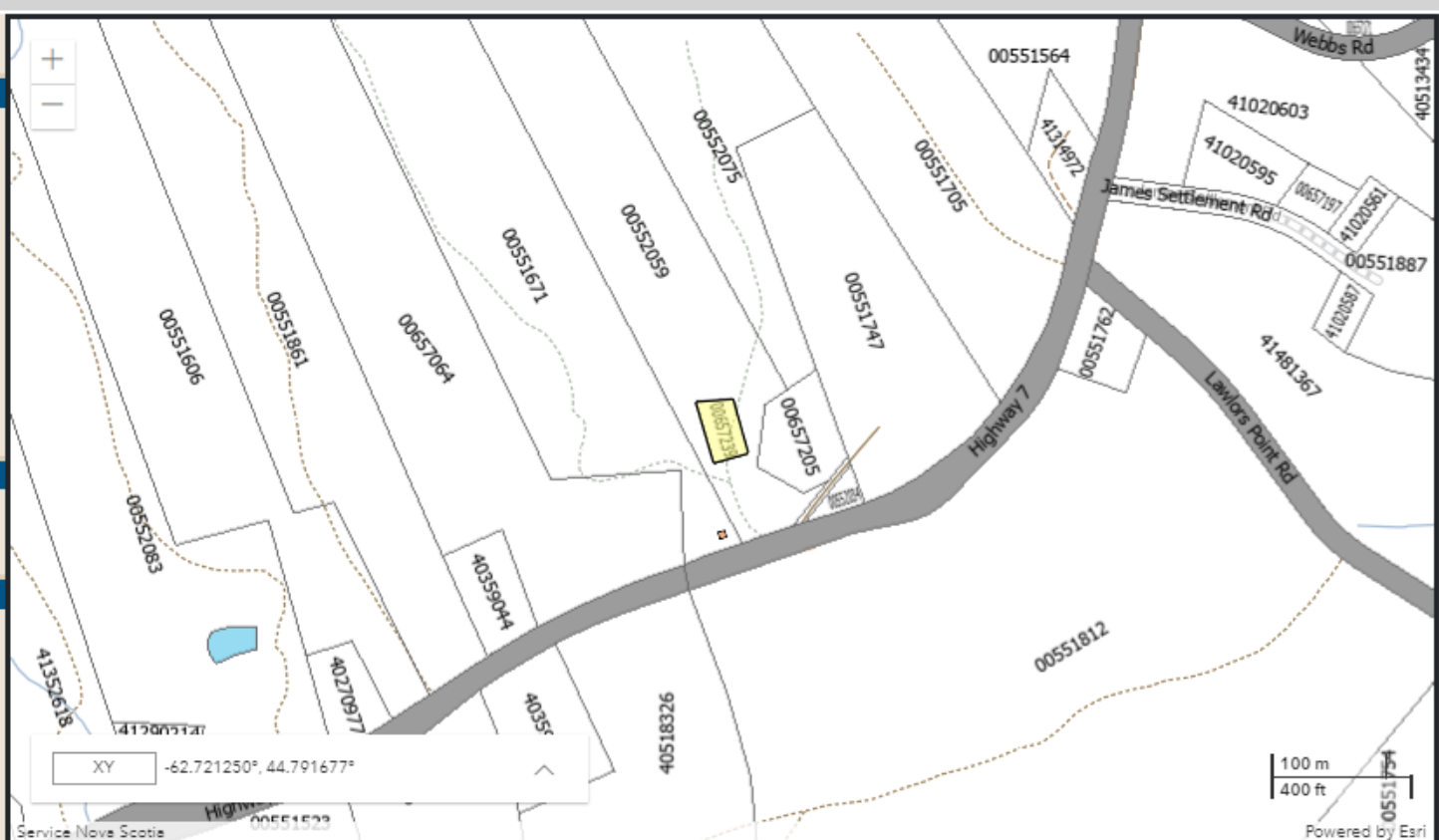
THENCE south 75 degrees 20 minutes west a distance 1.55 chains to a blazed fir tree;
