Mission and Description of Services Provided

(including who the services are provided to)

The Prospect Road Recreation Association (PPRA) is responsible for the fair allocation of area rate funds to recreation groups in the catchment area from West Dover to Goodwood. Recreation is broadly interpreted to include local youth sports, organizations, public amenities managed by local groups, and support to the Resource opportunities Centre that manages the Halifax-owned Prospect Road Community Centre. Area rate funds are estimated to be \$135,100 for the taxation year ended March 31, 2025. The PPRA also manages the mowing of sports fields, green spaces and parks with funds advanced by HRM Parks and Recreation. The PRRA will not renew the mowing contract when it expires in October, 2024

Accomplishments

(What has your organization accomplished in the past year?)

Community group funding for the year ended March 31, 2024 amounted to \$140,632 awarded to 15 local groups compared to 101,190 awarded to 11 local groups in the prior year. Additional program funding was \$3,191 compared to \$8,894 in the prior year. The decrease was due to the fact that the PRRA turned over operating responsibility for the Terence Bay wharf to HRM. Adminstrative expense we \$5,657 for the year ended March 31, 2024 compared to \$5,466 in the prior year.

Mowing expense was \$31,223 for the year ended March 31, 2004 compared to the same amount in 2023. During the year the PRRA entered into a renewed contract with HRM under which HRM reimburses the PRRA for mowing expenses for playing fields in our catchment area in return for field oversight by the PRRA. The The PRRA will not renew the mowing contract when it expires in October, 2024

Goals

(What does your organization plan to accomplish between April 1, 2024 and March 31, 2025)

1.	Maintain the board of directors at 12, the maximum permitted in the by-laws is 12.
2.	Continue governance education for the board.
3.	Adjudicate application for our Legacy grant program designed to disburse surplus funds. Estimated to be three grants of \$40,000 or the equivalent. The board is recommending to members that surplus funds be held for special projects of a long-term benefit.
4.	Oversee the disbursement of the current budget of \$113,572 including a review of documentation for budgeted expenditure by local recreation groups.
5.	Hold at least 6 directors' meetings during the year, 3 of which will be to all residents in the catchment area.
6.	Advertise widely the availability of area rate funds for recreation within the catchment area.
7.	Continue transparency regarding financial stewardship of public funds [the area rate]
